---

- ✓ Users with handheld inkjet printers
- ✓ Those requiring high-yield white ink
- ✓ Printers needing water-based white ink
- ✓ Users looking for compatible cartridges



## Who It Is Not For

---

- ✗ Users needing color ink cartridges
- ✗ Those requiring low-yield options
- ✗ Printers incompatible with AITER-45 WHITE

## Trade Offs to Consider

---

- Higher yield may increase cartridge size
- Water-based ink may fade over time
- Limited to specific printer models
- No built-in ink level indicators
