---

- ✗ Users who need direct USB printing
- ✗ Those with limited home space for a printer
- ✗ Users requiring high-speed monochrome printing



## Trade Offs to Consider

---

- Limited mobile app features compared to newer models
- Print speed is slower than laser printers
- Ink costs more over time than toner
- No built-in memory card reader
- Requires regular maintenance for optimal performance
- Not ideal for large document printing
- Smaller print resolution than high-end printers

## How It Compares

---

- Slower than laser printers for high-volume use
- Less energy-efficient than newer models
- Smaller print resolution than high-end printers
- No built-in memory card reader
- Not ideal for large document printing
- Higher ink costs over time
- Fewer advanced features in the mobile app
