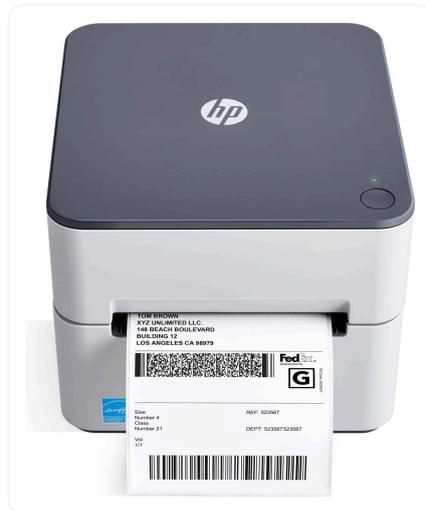

Who It Is For

-  Users needing thermal printing without ink
-  Warehouses requiring fast label printing

-  Users printing labels up to 5 inches wide
-  Users with limited space for label printers

Who It Is Not For

-  Users needing color printing
-  Users needing dual-sided printing
-  Users printing on paper instead of labels
-  Users requiring high-speed printing beyond 7 inches per second
-  Users needing a large label size beyond 5 inches
-  Users needing a heavy-duty industrial printer

Trade Offs to Consider

-  No color printing capability
-  Limited to single-sided printing
-  No built-in software for label design
-  Requires compatible shipping platforms
-  No automatic label loading
-  Limited media size beyond 4x6 inches

How It Compares

- Better than inkjet for label printing
- Slower than laser printers for documents
- More compact than industrial printers
- Less versatile than inkjet printers
- Better for thermal printing than laser
- More expensive than basic label printers
